Dr. Thara Rangaswamy is a psychiatrist by training and the co-Founder and Vice Chairman, of a not for profit NGO called SCARF (Schizophrenia Research Foundation) in the city of Chennai in Tamil Nadu. After her PhD on the subject of disability, she lobbied hard for the recognition of mental disability in India. She has collaborated with premier institutions around the world such as the Johns Hopkins, USA, Institute of Psychiatry, UK and others in Australia, Canada etc. She has over 180 peer reviewed publications. She is on the Advisory Committee to the Director General of the World Health Organization, Geneva and is on the editorial Board of several reputed journals including the Schizophrenia Bulletin. She was awarded the Honorary Fellowship of the Royal College of Psychiatrists, UK in 2014 and also the Presidents Gold Medal from the Royal College, UK in 2012. She was recognized by the Schizophrenia International Research Society (SIRS) for her research in clinical and community psychiatry in 2019.
